

3:30 pm Harvest Day Parade Guidelines and Route

Parade Guidelines:

- 1. All entries must be consistent with the theme of "Midwest Old Threshers" (Bandanas, Overalls, Straw, Etc)
- 2. Distribution of political material is allowed during the parade.
- 3. Companies, organizations, and politicians may display signs.
- 4. Candy can be distributed during the parade.
- 5. All entries must keep pace with the parade.

Parade Route:

- 1. Units for Old Threshers will exit grounds at Exit Gate on Walnut St or W2 Gate on Locust St.
- 2. Cars, Trucks units should assemble at (1) along the south side of Webster St facing east.
- 3. Steam Engines units should assemble at (2) along the east side of Walnut St facing north arriving approximately 3:15 pm.
- 4. Horse units should assemble at (3) along the south side of Green facing east.
- 5. BANDS, DIGNITARIES, AND FLOATS WILL ASSEMBLE ALONG SHEAFFER PARK CIRCLE (4) FACING NORTH STARTING AT 2:00 pm.
- 6. The HARVEST PARADE will begin at 3:30 pm following the route shown: north on Walnut to Washington, South on Washington to South Jefferson.
- 7. Order of the Parade: Police & State Patrol, MP Band, Grand Marshall, Mayor, IWU, Steam Engines, Floats, Horses, Floats, Cars & Trucks and Tractors
- 8. The HARVEST PARADE will officially end on South Jefferson (5) where units disperse.
- 9. Old Threshers units should turn south on Locust (6) and enter grounds at W2
